Food Services Re-entry Plan

The Dining Facility will provide quality meals to students, faculty, and staff of Navajo Technical University. Safe and sanitary environment will be aligned with the NM State Environmental Agency, at all times.

I. Requirements:

1. All students, faculty, staff and outside customers must wear a facemask upon entering the Dining Facility.
2. All who enter the dining hall must sign in at the cashiers' desk upon payment.
3. All meals are "to-go" until further notice of the Governor's Office to allow indoor dining.
4. The Multi-Purpose room is not available for any purpose until further notice.
5. Children are allowed and must be masked and under guardian's supervision at all times.
6. Food service employees will take customers' temperatures prior to gaining access to the main food line.
7. All CDC guidelines shall be maintained. Food line path is marked for 6' distance to maintain social distancing. Only one customer at a time is allowed to approach the food line for meal selection.
8. Occupancy Limits at any given time will be no more than 22 customers in line at 6 ft apart. There is no inside serving at the present time.

II. Food Service Staff Responsibilities:

1. Monitor & maintain hand sanitizer stations to ensure filled to capacity at all times. Hand sanitizer stations are located at the front cafeteria doors.
2. Wipe down food service line on a regular basis during the meal hours.
3. When indoor seating is allowed, all tables and chairs will be wiped down at the conclusion of the meal. Signs, "*This chair & table section needs to be sanitized*", will be issued to customers to leave on the tables, indicating areas to be sanitized.
4. While serving, gloves and masks will be used at all times.
5. Handwashing between glove uses is mandatory.
6. Daily check with residential for number of residential students in quarantine for meal pick-up.
7. Food Service employees will have their temperature checked when they clock in and when they clock out

III. Security:

1. Will continue to do a walk-through of the cafeteria and dining area.
2. Will sign-in at the front cashier's desk to document regular rounds.
3. Will assist in removing unruly or non-compliant students from Food Service.
